**LAW CLERK HIRING INFORMATION**  
**Barbara Moses, United States Magistrate Judge**

Magistrate Judge Moses hires for two clerkships each year. One begins in March and one begins in September. Each is for a one-year term. Judge Moses has completed hiring through the September 2017 term. Future positions (beginning with the March 2018 term) will be posted on OSCAR approximately one year in advance of the anticipated start date.

Candidates should have at least one year of practice experience, preferably including matters in the federal courts, before the start of the term for which they are applying. Applications should be submitted through OSCAR and include a cover letter, resume, law school transcript, three letters of recommendation (at least one from a supervisor familiar with the candidate's post-law school work), and a recent writing sample. If the writing sample is not entirely the candidate's own work, the nature and extent of contributions from others should be noted.
